The meeting took place on January 28, 2026 and was called to order at 1:00pm to discuss the purchase of a new quint fire truck for the Fire Department.

The Fire Department presented the proposal package for the purchase of a new quint fire truck and addressed questions from committee members and administration.

Expected cost for a new quint truck is estimated to between \$1.5 and \$1.8 million dollars, and the city currently has \$500,000 in a fund for this purchase. The remainder will be financed via a bond or loan. The lead time for a new truck is 12-16 months from the time of order and our current fire ladder truck we are replacing is 29 years old. The fire department's proposal package is attached to these minutes as an appendix.

Following discussion, it is the recommendation of the committee that the City move forward with a resolution to solicit bids for the purchase of the quint fire truck.
