- Residents must show proof of residency to receive resident pricing for memberships and daily rates.
- Memberships can be purchased at Cheviot City Hall Monday-Friday 8am-3:45pm.
- Beginning June 1st, memberships can be purchased at the pool.
- Swim lessons are free for members. Non-members the cost is \$15 for resident and \$25 for Non-Resident.
- Water Aerobics are free for members, \$5 for non-members and are held on Thursdays at 8PM & Saturdays at 11am.

Discipline Policy

- The city exercises the right to remove or revoke any person or persons who knowingly break the posted pool rules.
- In the event a youth is removed from the pool, his or her parents will be contacted and informed immediately by someone on the pool staff.
 - Removal from the pool could last one day or the entire pool season based on the facts of the infraction
 - Upon removal from the pool, that person shall leave the pool and the premise of Harvest Home Park.
 - This policy will be enforced by the pool manager who is given the authority by Steven L. Braun, Safety Service Director of The City of Cheviot.
