During the meeting we went point by point through the ordinances related to snow removal 131.04 and 92.09. Mostly it was centered around the effects and timing of removal related to public safety. General consensus was that the current 2 hours after sunrise to have snow removed was too limited. Items discussed and to be revisited in the future included possible assistance for homeowners who need it and possible use of city resources for common use areas such as bus stops.


Items to be drawn up for a new law will include changing to a 24 hour from end of snow event timeline. We would like to put a timer on the city web site to indicate the time past since the official end of the snow event. Also, we intend to increase the fine from \$25 to \$50 for the first offense and leave subsequent ^{offenses} events at \$200. We plan to add a provision calling out that the offence count resets each October. We briefly touched on and tabled changing the parking infractions from criminal to civil violations and making feeding feral cats an offence.
