-Mayor Keller reported that he and Mr. Morgan met with the owners of the church building at the corner of Glenmore and Meadow regarding remedying the issue with the water drainage that affects neighboring properties, Mayor will ask that the city engineer reach out and let the owners know what needs to be done to correct the problems.

-Safety Service Director Braun reported that the paving portion has been completed on all current projects. Line striping is done on Bridgetown and Nolan Avenues. Pre-construction meeting will be held on the 18th for the Harvest Home Park project, with construction beginning by the end of the month, Mr. Braun also noted that no resolution is needed to accept the community event grant (West Fest).
